## Toggle Capo

Tab Attaches to Strap Clamps to Multi-Notched Base Bar

Pros: Inexpensive; Small, Light, Adjustable

Cons: Inaccurate, Strap stretches over time, Time consuming,  
Too many working parts

## Strap-On Capo

Elastic Band Connects to Bar via Eyeholes and Stem

Pros: Inexpensive, Light, Adjustable

Cons: Strap stretches over time, Eyeholes wear out, Time consuming

Approx Price: \$5.00



## Nashville Capo

Spring-Loaded Clamp Style

Pros: Quick Change, Inexpensive, Light Weight, Clamps to  
Headstock

Cons: Non-adjustable, May not be tight enough for some fret positions

Approx Price: \$14.00



## Keyser Capo

Spring-Loaded Clamp Style

Pros: Quick Change, Clamps to Head Stock, Firm Grip

Cons: Non-adjustable, High-Tension spring can cause fret wear  
Slightly expensive

Approx Price: \$17.00



## Shubb Capo

Adjustable Fulcrum Driven Clamp

Pros: Adjustable tension

Cons: Not a quick change—won't clamp to headstock, Must  
re-adjust at different frets, Expensive

Approx Price: \$20.00
